COURSE OVERVIEW

Designed for those who need to manage, undertake or understand how to conduct effective Root Cause investigation and analysis. The course will provide an overview of the regulatory framework and frequently used root cause analysis techniques. Common principles for effective root cause analysis will be highlighted and applied to real world scenarios. The delegates will practice the identification of root cause(s) including the evaluation of containment, corrective and preventive actions. The course will use case studies from occurrences and audit findings. The content of the course is closely aligned with the UK CAA CAP 1760 'Effective Problem Solving and Root Cause Identification' guidance material.

COURSE OBJECTIVE

- Recognise how effective root cause analysis can be used to improve the organisation's management system.
- Demonstrate an understanding of CAP1760 and its implications
- Select suitable containment, corrective and preventative actions
- Recognise the different roles and responsibilities in carrying out root cause analysis and addressing noncompliance
- Ensure that the process is adequately structured and documented
