3. INTRODUCTION

A CAAM audit on the C of A renewal for 9M-PMB had been carried out on 16th August 2018 at CAMO office in MIAT. From the audit, the CAAM inspector had raised a concern on the traceability of the AJL pages.

Each booklet of the AJL contain 50 pages with its unique serialized number and are not specific to aircraft registration. Due to inconsistent serial number between two logbooks for a particular aircraft, this notice is raised to ensure the continuity of AJL pages can be clearly defined.

4. REQUIREMENT

In the event to transfer the data to a new AJL, the contracted AMO's Maintenance Engineer shall enter a statement in the defect and rectification column, by write down the new AJL Page Serial Number where the data is transferred. The sample as attached.

The Technical Records personnel have to ensure that the data are correctly entered and the reference of AJL Serial Number between two log books are available whenever the AJL Data transferring is take place.
