Thank you for seeing 34 year old lady, P3 with newly diagnosed left breast cancer

She presented left breast lump. Clinically on left breast - + lump vague 2x2cm at 6-7 o'clock with another 1x1cm at 8 o'clock. No LN palpable. No skin infiltration

US breast showed a multifocal suspicious left breast lesions at the lower quadrants and mildly enlarged left axillary lymph node. .

MMG - several ill defined lesions with spiculated borders seen in the mid lower quadrant of the left breast. Minimal surrounding architectural distortion seen. Multiple clustered, grouped and suspicious microcalcifications are seen within these lesions. Mildly retracted skin seen at the inferior aspect of the left areolar region.

US guided biopsy of left breast at 6 o'clock - invasive carcinoma with ER/PR-ve, CerB2 3+ ( FISH test is pending), Ki 67 60-70%

Imp : Multifocal left breast cancer with ER/PR -ve and CerB2 3+

**MANAGEMENT / MEDICATION :**

Please kindly seeing her for primary systemic chemotargetted therapy before surgery and PET scan for her.

I advised her for mastectomy with reconstruction upon completion of treatment.
