Accept your offer

The <u>Student Acceptance and Payment Agreement</u> is a contract between you and the University. Completing the online form is the first step to <u>Get Started</u> at Melbourne . You can view the Agreement online and it is important that you read it carefully and save a copy for your records. You can then submit the online form to accept your offer. Once you've completed the Agreement online you'll receive your Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) which you'll need to obtain a student visa.

International students are required to purchase Visa Length Cover at the time of accepting their offer. If you have been granted and accept advanced standing in your course the course duration may change, which in turn will change the Overseas Student Health Cover you are required to purchase.
