# TECHNICAL AIRWORTHINESS ORDER – CONTINUING AIRWORTHINESS MANAGEMENT (TAO-M)

## **INTRODUCTION**

- 1. Technical Airworthiness Advisory Circular (TAAC) is a type of document issued by the TAR to provide instructions and means for compliance with technical airworthiness regulations.
- 2. State Aircraft Operator/State Registered Aircraft Operator (SAO/SRAO) that are responsible for Configuration Item (CI) management of the whole aircraft are required to have Continuing Airworthiness Management Organisation (CAMO) approval from DGTA.
- 3. TAO-M CAMO Organisational Approval with the scope of approval according to aircraft type will be awarded by DGTA upon successful demonstrating compliance with the compliance audit requirement under TAO-M.
- 4. TAAC-E-003 Revision 2 will be partly superseded by this TAAC. The Certificate of Airworthiness Renewal (CoA Renewal) requirement will now be under TAO-M M.A.710 Airworthiness Review, where new procedures have been introduced as required in TAO-M.

#### **PURPOSE**

8. Under the previous Technical Airworthiness Regulations, State Aircraft Operator/State Registered Aircraft Operator (SAO/SRAO) that are responsible for Configuration Item (CI) management of the whole aircraft are required to have an Authorised Engineering Organisation (AEO).

- 9. However, both EMAR M and EASA Part M regulations require these organisations to have Organisation Approval for Continuing Airworthiness Management. Technical Airworthiness Orders Continuing Airworthiness Management (TAO-M) aligns with EMAR M and EASA Part M.
- 10. This TAAC introduces for TAO-M to issue and regulate the organisational approval for SAO/SRAO and introduces a new procedure in CoA Renewal for state aircraft.

## **ORGANISATION AFFECTED**

- 11. This Technical Airworthiness Advisory Circular (TAAC) is applicable to:
  - a. State Aircraft Operator (SAO) responsible for Configuration Item (CI) management of the whole aircraft.
  - b. State Aircraft Operator (SAO) that holds AEO for CI management of the whole aircraft will now be subjected to TAO-M.
  - c. State Registered Aircraft Operator (SRAO) responsible for stateregistered aircraft maintenance activities shall apply for CAMO organisation approval under TAO-M.

## **EFFECTIVE**

- 12. The instructions are effective upon receiving this TAAC and TAO-M, Issue No: Interim, dated 28 June 2021. Both documents can be accessed through the DGTA portal.
- 13. For CAMO approval, SAOs are to comply and implement within two (2) years, starting from the date of this TAAC but not later than **31 Dis 2024**.
- 14. For CAMO approval, SRAO/Commercial Organisations holding DGTA AMO approval are to comply before **31 Dec 2022** with the following processes:
  - a. To obtain a sponsorship letter from MAO and submit it during application.
  - b. To submit documents pertaining to CAMO application as mentioned in Para 17.
- 15. For State Aircraft Operator (SAO) that holds AEO approval for the scope of CI management of the whole aircraft may opt to be subjected under TAO-M once the validity of current certification expires **or** may opt to comply and implement within two (2) years starting from the date of this TAAC but not later than **31 Dis 2024**.
- 16. For CoA Renewal, from **01 Jan 2023**, both SAO/SRAO shall be subjected to Airworthiness Review under TAO-M M.A.710 and M.A.901.

## **REQUIREMENT**

- 17. For CAMO approval, State Aircraft Operator /State Registered Aircraft Operator (SAO/SRAO) are required to:
  - a. Nominate CAMO Post Holders for DGTA approval.
  - b. Develop and submit Continuing Airworthiness Management Exposition (CAME) during application.
  - c. Develop Aircraft Maintenance Programme (AMP) and submit it during application.
  - d. Submit Aircraft Technical Log(s).
  - e. Submit Technical specification of Maintenance Contract (if applicable) with an AMO.
  - f. Submit proof of authorisation from relevant MAO or Government of Malaysia, whichever is applicable.
  - g. Submit any additional documentation required by DGTA.
- 18. For SAO/SRAO applying for CoA Renewal:
  - a. an application form for renewal of Certificate of Airworthiness (TAO-M Form 15d) is to be submitted.
  - b. TAO-M M.A.710 Airworthiness Review, M.A.901- Aircraft airworthiness review, AMC/GM and Appendix to M.A.710 must be read together.
  - c. Form 15d is downloadable through the DGTA portal.

#### **VERIFICATION AUDIT**

19. Verification Audit shall be conducted by DGTA as scheduled to verify compliance with this TAAC and Technical Airworthiness Regulations.
