<b>SUBJECT</b>	Mandatory Training _ Initial and recurrent.		

### **Background**

Initial and recurrent training are essential components of aviation safety, ensuring that aviation personnel in general and maintenance personnel in particular are well-prepared and current with the required skills and knowledge to maintain an aircraft safely. These training aim to reduce risks, improve decision-making skills, and maintain a high level of competency among aviation professionals.

### **Applicability**

This notice applies to all AMO personnel as stated in the GAM MOE and GAM EPM for state registered aircraft.

### **Compliance**

AMO personnel must receive initial training within 3 month upon joining the organisation. The recurrent training must be completed every two years in accordance with GAM-approved publications.

Training shall be scheduled by the GAM training department for personnel to attend; however, it is the personnel's responsibility to remain current.

Failure to comply with the requirement will result in the suspension or revocation of Company Authorization by QAM.
