## **RULES OF MOVEMENT AREA**

- 1. The driver of a vehicle shall not overtake and pass any other vehicle proceeding in the same direction in the movement area.
- 2. No person shall park a vehicle in or near manoeuvring area or on a route of communication on the apron.
- 3. Equipment that is infrequently used & unserviceable must be LABELLED and TOWED to the nearest temporary staging area.
- 4. Vehicles must not be driven underneath the Passenger Boarding Bridge (PBB).
- 5. Vehicles/Equipment must not be parked inside the PBB Clearance zone (red hatches)
- 6. The person in charge of a vehicle shall not leave the vehicle unattended in the movement area and in the event of a breakdown he shall attract attention to his plight.
- 7. Do not leave defective trolleys/trailers/dollies inside the aircraft movement areas.
- 8. No driver of any vehicle in the movement area shall start the vehicle when it is in the vicinity of an aircraft which is being refuelled.
- 9. No person shall drive a vehicle in the movement area between an aircraft and a kerb of the apron when the aircraft is parked at a bay adjacent to the kerb in such a position that no free way is available for the unrestricted movement of the vehicle.
- 10. The driver of every vehicle proceeding along the runway or taxiway shall, as far as practicable, keep the vehicle to the right side of the runway or taxiway.
- 11. No vehicle shall be towed by another vehicle in the movement area unless a suitable tow bar is used for that purpose.
- 12. No person, other than the driver of a vehicle, shall travel in any vehicle in the movement area unless he is seated in a passenger seat provided in the vehicle or is standing in a section of the vehicle which has been constructed for standing passengers.
- 13. No person shall leave any refuse or litter on the apron.
- 14. Every person who is engaged in the work of servicing an aircraft shall inspect the parking bay immediately after the aircraft has been serviced to ensure that objects such as nuts, bolts and split pins are not left lying about.
- 15. No person shall smoke on the apron or in the hangars.
