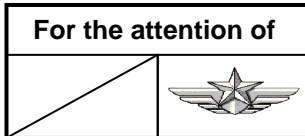

The purpose of this revision is to inform about a new aircraft in the available PDFs and about a related EASA publication.

Ground Rescue Booklet - PDF format

A Ground Rescue Booklet provides general and safety-related information concerning an aircraft and shall only be considered as a support for users to prepare their own documentation. The booklets will not systematically be updated in line with the aircraft modification process. Depending on the country and the modification status of the helicopter, systems may differ in location.

Airbus Helicopters has already published documents for H125, H130, H135, EC145, H145, AS365, H155, H175 and H225 helicopters, which can be downloaded free of charge from AirbusWorld. A copy is also available [on the Airbus Helicopters website](#), in the Safety subsection.

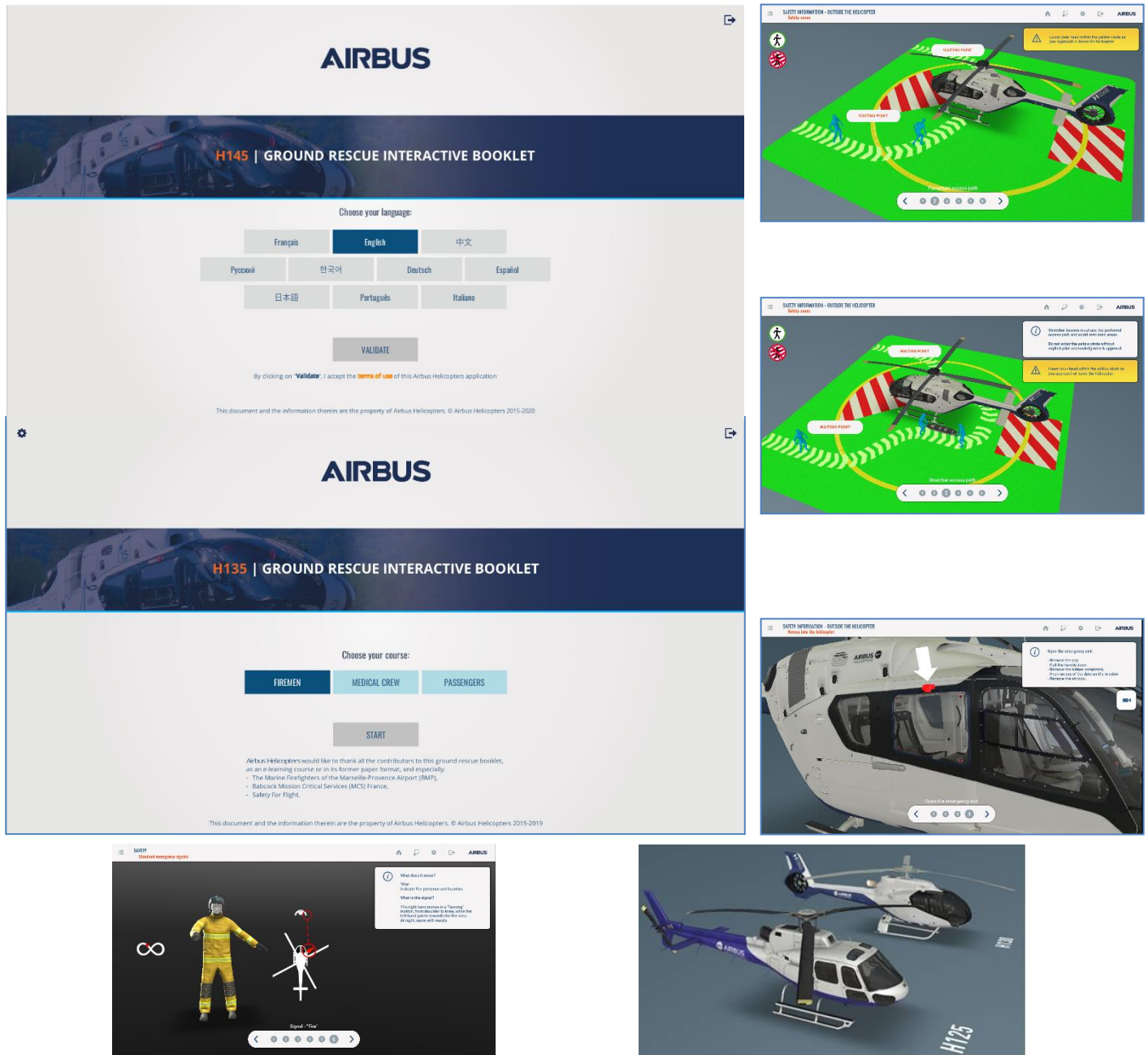
Ground Rescue Booklet - e-learning format

They include a reminder of the emergency marshalling signs and are downloadable for free [on the Airbus Helicopters website](#). They are available as an executable (.exe) or directly consultable through an internet browser (html).
