REINSTATEMENT OF AIR TRAFFIC SERVICES (ATS) OPERATIONAL HOURS AT AERODROMES AS PUBLISHED IN THE AERONAUTICAL INFORMATION PUBLICATION (AIP)

1 Introduction

- 1.1 Following the announcement by the Government of Malaysia on the reopening of the country's borders for international travel and the transition into endemic phase of COVID-19 effective 1st of April 2022, airline operators are expected to increase flight frequencies of their flights.
- 1.2 This Advisory Information (AI) is to notify the aviation industry that Air Traffic Services (ATS) provided by the Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) is fully ready to reinstate pre-pandemic capacities and support the anticipated increase in air traffic within Malaysian airspace.

2 Aerodromes Operational Hours

- 2.1 To facilitate the anticipated increase in air traffic, the operating hours of ATS at all aerodromes managed by CAAM shall be reinstated from 1 April 2022, in accordance with the time stipulated in AIP Malaysia.
