IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW CIVIL AVIATION GUIDANCE MATERIALS EFFECTIVE 1ST OCTOBER 2021

1 Introduction

- 1.1 The Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) has issued **16** new Civil Aviation Guidance Materials (CAGM) to provide guidance for Flight Operations and Airworthiness related Civil Aviation Directives (CAD). The CAGMs are provided to support organisations to ensure compliance with the provisions laid in the CAD published in exercise of the powers conferred by section 24O of the Civil Aviation Act 1969 [Act 3].
