# IMPLEMENTATION OF REVISED CIVIL AVIATION DIRECTIVES AND CIVIL AVIATION GUIDANCE MATERIALS EFFECTIVE $15^{TH}$ NOVEMBER 2021

## 1 Introduction

1.1 A Notice of Proposed Rule Making (NPRM) was issued by the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) via a Civil Aviation Notice (CAN) 011/2021 on the 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2021, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 24O of the Civil Aviation Act 1969 [Act 3], prior to the implementation of the Civil Aviation Directives (CADs) below:

1.3 The purpose of this NPRM was to benefit from the knowledge of pilots, airlines, aviation related training organisations and/or other aviation service providers in the development of these new Directives.

# 2 Responses

2.1 There was a total of 7 responses from 3 organisations received during this NPRM process. Responses, where necessary and requested, were sent out to the relevant organisations that provided the feedback. The last response was sent on the 10<sup>th</sup> of November 2021. CAAM would like to express our gratitude to all organisations that participated in this rule making process.

# 3 Notable Changes

3.1 Upon completion of the review process of all the responses received, amendments were made as required. Some of the notable changes are:

## 4 Effective Date and Revocation
