CAAM OPERATIONS DURING THE MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER

PUTRAJAYA – Pursuant to the extension of 'total lockdown' across the country as announced by the Government of Malaysia for a period of 14 days from 15 June 2021 to 28 June 2021, the Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM) will make the following changes to its operations:

- 1) Closure of CAAM One Stop Centre (OSC). All air crew with appointments made on e-temujanji after 15th June 2021 will be notified on the postponement via email.
- 2) Approved Training Organisation Type Rating Training Organization (ATO-TRTO) are allowed to operate for recurrent training only and subject to full compliance to SOPs.
- 3) Permit application for carriage of dangerous goods will be done online via www.bless.gov.my. Collection of approved application can be made at the designated drop box located at Lobby, Podium A, CAAM Putrajaya on Monday to Friday from 09:00am to 04:00pm.
- 4) For any matters pertaining Airworthiness Division and Aerodrome Standards Division, a drop box is placed at Lobby, Podium A, CAAM Putrajaya on Monday to Friday from 09:00am to 04:00pm for the purpose of submitting applications and other relevant documents. Fee payments shall be made via Electronic Fund Transfer and submissions after 01:00pm will only be processed the next working day. All licences issued by Airworthiness Division will be sent to applicants via courier.
- 5) Closure of Approved Training Organisation Flying Training Organisation (ATO-FTO), Flying Clubs and Maintenance Training Organisation (MTO). All classes are to be conducted online.
- 6) CAAM will continue its surveillance and monitoring on industry via online meetings.
- 7) Suspension of all examinations conducted by CAAM.

CAAM is closely monitoring the situation regarding COVID-19 and should there be any changes to the current status, CAAM will notify its aviation stakeholders accordingly.
