TRANSITION PERIOD FOR MAINTENANCE TRAINING ORGANISATION CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION

1 Introduction

- 1.1 This Civil Aviation Notice (CAN) is issued by the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Civil Aviation Authority of Malaysia (CAAM), herein referred to as the Civil Aviation Notice (CAN) 001/2022, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 24O of the Civil Aviation Act 1969 [Act 3].
- 1.2 This CAN exempts Maintenance Training Organisations (MTO) from the requirement in paragraph 1.2.1 (5), Attachment 4 of Civil Aviation Circular (CAC) 08/2021 Revised CADs and CAGM Requirements and Guidance.

2 Purpose

- 2.1 CAC 08/2021 which is effective 1st January 2022 requires examination papers developed by MTO to meet the latest requirements in Appendix 1, 2 and 3 of CAD 1801, and the examination papers shall be approved by CAAM.
- 2.2 In order to facilitate the conduct of examinations, effective from 11th January 2022 and until 15th February 2022, MTOs are allowed to continue the conduct of examination using previously approved examination papers that are exempted as specified in paragraph 1.2 above.
- 2.3 During this transitional period, MTOs shall submit examination papers with completed examination question compliance checklist (CAAM/AW/1841-02) that meets the requirement of CAC 08/2021 (Attachment 4, paragraph 1.2.1) for CAAM approval. Examination paper approved prior to CAC 08/2021 that wish to be utilised by MTO shall also be reviewed against the CAC and submitted for CAAM approval.

- After 15th February 2022, MTOs are not allowed to conduct examination, unless the examination papers have met the requirement of CAC 08/2021 (Attachment 4, paragraph 1.2.1) and paragraph 2.3 above. For basic licence examination, MTOs without examination paper approval may engage the services of CAAM examination centres which can be found in AME examination portal accessible in CAAM website (https://www.caam.gov.my/e-services-forms/e-exam_ame_fc/).
- 2.5 All other requirements in CAD 1821 remains applicable based on the effective dates and compliance shall be demonstrated by the MTO accordingly.
