AEROSPATIALE AS 350 ALL MODELS (ASTAR AND ECUREWIL)

OPTIONAL CARGO SWING INSTALLATION

(STANDBY MECHANICAL CONTROL WITH INCREASED TRAVEL)

This directive is applicable to AS 350 helicopters, all models equipped with a Cargo Swing installation not modified according to AMS 350A.07.0890 (standby mechanical control with increased travel).

Following several cases of accidental releases of loads due to an excessive sensitivity of the mechanical release control, it was decided that the incorporation of several remedial actions to this control shall become mandatory. These improvements are detailed in Aerospatiale AS 350 Service Bulletin n° 25.19. They shall be applied before the first load carrying missions following the date on which the present directive has become applicable.
