CHECKING THE BONDING OF STAINLESS STELL PROTECTIONS ON LEADING EDGES

Following several case of severe bonding separation of stainless steel protections on leading edges of above referenced blades, found at a low following measures have been rendered mandatory:

- Inspection of bonding in accordance with the "sounding" method described in work card AS  $355\,n^{\circ}\,64.10.00.601$  in which the permissible separation criteria are detailed.

This inspection should be performed:

- A) For blades between 0 and 100 operating hours since new or overhaul Following the first flight of each blade, then every 10 hours of flight until accumulation of 10 hour of flight.
- B) For blades with more than 100 operating hours since new or overhaul
  Within the 10 hours of flight following the effective date of the directive to confirm the effectiveness of the inspections normaly performed in accordance with maintenance recommendations in force.
- NOTE: in addition to the requirements of the present directive the instructions given in the master servicing recommendations (MSR) are to be complied with in the normal way. MSR AS 355, CH 5.41, P. 1 is the subject of a temporary amendment (fast circulation procedure) to include the checks rendered mandatory by the present directive.
