Subsequent to an accident involving an AS 350 B2 helicopter, the following measures are rendered mandatory.

- 1/ Irrespective of the number of operating hours logged by the rotor mast, should abnormal noises appear (metal rubbing) in flight or when the rotor is turning on the ground, stop flights immediately and perform the checks described in paragraphs DD (A) or (B) and the actions described in paragraph EE of EUROCOPTER Telex Service N° 01-41.
- 2/ On receipt of the present Airworthiness Directive, all rotor mast shafts on which operations requiring the removal of the mast epicyclic reduction gear assembly have been performed within the last 100 flying hours (if not performed by EUROCOPTER Marignane), must be subjected to checks in accordance with paragraphs DD (A) or (B) and actions described in paragraph EE of EUROCOPTER Telex Service N° 01-41.
