1. EFFECTIVITY:

EC 155 version B helicopters. This Airworthiness Directive covers the pilot's and copilot's doors and the passengers' hinged doors and sliding doors.

2. REASONS:

This Airworthiness Directive (AD) is issued following two reports of opening of the passengers' hinged doors in flight. The results of the investigations showed non-compliant installation and adjustment of the door locking mechanisms, which can result in door unlocking and involve a risk of losing the door in flight.

Revision 1 of this AD takes into account the conversion of EC 155 B Alert Telex No. 52A008 into an Alert Service Bulletin (ASB) bearing the same reference number, with no change to the technical content.

3. MANDATORY ACTIONS AND COMPLIANCE TIME:

- **3.1.** No later than within the next 25 flight hours from the effective date of the original issue of this AD, check and adjust the position of the locking pins on each door in compliance with the instructions specified in paragraph 2.B of referenced EUROCOPTER EC 155 ASB No. 52A008.
- **3.2.** Each time you replace one of the doors specified in above paragraph 1, comply with the instructions specified in paragraph 2.B of the referenced ASB.
