#### 1. **EFFECTIVITY**:

EUROCOPTER EC 155 B and B1 helicopters, all serial numbers fitted with one or two cabin sliding door(s), before embodiment of modification (MOD) 0753C49 or before compliance with Technical Directive (TD) No. 53C009.

Note: This Airworthiness Directive (AD) is intended for maintenance personnel and crews.

## 2. REASONS:

This AD is issued following two cases of in-flight loss of cabin sliding doors.

Compliance with this AD will cancel:

- the check for correct engagement of the roller in the rail and the door-open locking latch before a flight with the door open,
- the sliding door opening/closing restriction at airspeeds above 40 kt covered by AD No. F-2003-345 R2.

## 3. MANDATORY ACTIONS AND COMPLIANCE TIMES:

The following measures are rendered mandatory as from the effective date of this AD.

- **3.1.** At the latest by January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2006, replace the original rails with modified rails and install new fittings on the doors, in compliance with the instructions specified in § 2.B. of referenced EUROCOPTER EC 155 Alert Service Bulletin (ASB) No. 53A008.
- **3.2.** At the latest by January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2006, retrofit doors held in your stores as spares, in compliance with the instructions specified in § 2.B.5. of the referenced ASB.
