1. **EFFECTIVITY**:

EC 155 B and B1 helicopters, all serial numbers equipped with one or two cabin sliding door(s), which do not incorporate EUROCOPTER modifications (MOD) 0752C18 and 0753C59.

Note: This Airworthiness Directive (AD) is intended for maintenance personnel and crews.

2. REASONS:

This AD is issued further to a case of simultaneous loss of two cabin sliding doors in flight. The purpose of this AD is to reinforce the attachment of sliding door forward centering pin supports and centering pin receptacles in the door frame on structure side.

Compliance with this AD cancels the 140 kt Vne limitation introduced by AD F-2004-060.

3. MANDATORY ACTIONS AND COMPLIANCE TIMES:

The following measures are rendered mandatory as from the effective date of this AD:

- **3.1.** At the latest by January 1, 2006, comply with the instructions specified in § 2.B. of referenced EUROCOPTER EC 155 Alert Service Bulletin (ASB) No. 52A017.
- **3.2.** Comply with the instructions specified in § 2.B.2. of the referenced ASB (reinforcement of sliding door forward centering pins per MOD 0752C18) before installing sliding doors, held as spares, on an aircraft, and at the latest by December 31, 2005.
