Subject: All engines
Maximum Storage Durations (MSD) of equipment

Dear Sir or Madam,

The purpose of this Service Letter is to provide you with additional information regarding the Maximum Storage Durations (MSD) of equipment:

- The generic rules are given in the engine maintenance manuals and the expiry date is usually indicated on the equipment packaging.
- The lists of equipment to which the generic rules apply are mentioned in chapter 5.15 of the engine maintenance manuals. Please note that these lists are updated through Tech Pub revisions.
- The start date of the MSD is the manufacturing date that features on the sticker of the equipment packaging.
- If there is no manufacturing date on the equipment packaging, the start date to be taken into account will be the date appearing on the release document (EASA or FAA certificates of compliance).
- If there is no release document available, the start date will then be the date on the document accompanying the delivery of the equipment.
- We remind you that for some equipment, the MSD on the identification label can be more restrictive. In this case, this label is to be obeyed.
