1 INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

This Safety Notice provides information in support of AW139 operators safety briefings and

demonstrations to passengers.

The contents of this Safety Notice are not supposed to replace the operators required

briefing/demonstrations, but rather to provide information in support of them.

The regulation EU No 965/2012 mandates the operator (commercial and non-commercial) to ensure

that briefings and demonstrations related to safety are provided to passengers in a form that

facilitates the application of the procedures applicable in case of an emergency and that passengers

are provided with a safety briefing card on which picture type-instructions indicate the operation of

emergency equipment and exits likely to be used by passengers.

The Safety Briefing Cards (SBC) material attached to this Safety Notice has been produced by LH

to effectively support customers (operators) to develop their own SBC. The proposed SBC standard

is defined in accordance with guidelines and practices recommended by EASA/FAA/ICAO, and

contains the minimum amount of safety instructions that shall be provided in the passenger safety

information briefing materials.

The SBC contains all the necessary information regarding safety features, emergency equipment

and emergency procedures onboard the aircraft which are provided for passengers to avoid injuries

and to enhance the chance of the passengers to survive any life threatening situation that might

occur while onboard the aircraft. The information given in these SBCs has to be specific for the

aircraft type or model and its emergency equipment.

The contents this Safety Notice are targeting two specific AW139 Life Raft ditching configurations

(Integrated and External). It is important to notice that other configuration details (such as the cabin

layouts, including seats number and position, safety equipment location, cabin furnishing and

Emergency Medical Service customizations) are different across the various AW139 aircraft

operations and configurations. It is not the intent of this Safety Notice to cover all possible

configuration specificities, and the information provided by this safety notice is not meant to replace

the specific markings provided onboard, which remain in any case the valid reference to be used.

It is considered as operator responsibility to confirm that the information provided in this document

is adequate and conform to the specific operated helicopter configuration, or to complement and

adapt as required.

With respect to (T-)PEDs (Transmitting Portable Electronic Devices) it is reminded here that the

AW139 model has been demonstrated as tolerant to (T-)PED radio frequency emissions (to the

extent of the EASA Certification requirements and with exceptions/limitations identified in ref. [1]).

However it is reminded the operator's responsibility to authorize the on-board use of (T-)PEDs in

regards of all aspects and of the specific flight conditions/phases, as supervised by the relevant

National Aviation Authority.
