## Dear Customer,

With the present letter Leonardo Helicopters (LH) wishes to provide you with advanced information on Service Bulletins (SB) that are going to be released and affecting the fire extinguishers P/N P3APP003010A installed on AW139, AW169 and AW189 helicopters or kept in stock.

Following a report from the manufacturer of a non-conformity on Fire Extinguisher P/N P3APP003010A, LH decided to precautionary prescribe the replacement of the potentially affected Fire Extinguishers P/N P3APP003010A with the Fire Extinguishers P/N P3APP003010D. This measure will be released via the following Service Bulletins:

AW139: SB139-671AW169: SB169-200AW189: SB189-298

Please note that after the application of the SB, the helicopters will not be anymore affected by the EASA Airworthiness Directive AD No. 2021-0185.

Please be informed that the quantity of Fire Extinguishers P/N P3APP003010D needed to accomplish the SB will be defined according to the quantity of potentially non-conforming components to be replaced and they will be provided on a Free of Charge basis. The relevant MMIR form must be accompanied by the "Scrap Report" (relevant form will be available within the SB) and by pictures for each of the affected component.

## Fire extinguisher replacement

## Please note that:

- following the accomplishment of the aforementioned SB, in case of part replacement, only Fire Extinguishers P/N P3APP003010D will be allowed to be installed;
- starting from the date of issue of the aforementioned SB, only Fire Extinguishers P/N P3APP003010D will be provided as spare parts and the IETP will be updated accordingly.
