
Procedure




Figure 1 Bird strike protection - Install procedure

- 1 Get access to the bird strike protection (1, Figure 1) in front of the forward bulkhead in the nose avionic bay.
- 2 Hold the bird strike protection (1) with your hands.
- Remove these parts that attach the bird strike protection (1) to the forward bulkhead:
 - The six nuts (2)
 - The six washers (3)
 - The six bolts (4).
- 4 Remove the bird strike protection (1) from the helicopter.

Requirements After Job Completion

1 Install the bird strike protection. Refer to 39-B-25-69-01-00A-720A-A (See Annex 2 of this TMI)

Safety Conditions

WARNING

The Cleaning solvent (C010) is a dangerous material. Before you do this procedure, make sure that you know all the safety precautions and first aid instructions for the cleaning solvent.

Procedure

- 1 Clean the mating surface between the bird strike protection (1, Figure 1) and the forward bulkhead with the Lint-free cloth (C011) and the Cleaning solvent (C010).
- 2 Dry the parts you cleaned with a clean Lint-free cloth (C011).
- 3 Put the bird strike protection (1) in its position on the forward bulkhead.
- 4 Hold the bird strike protection (1) in that position with your hands.
- Make sure that the attach holes in the bird strike protection (1) and those on the forward bulkhead are aligned.
- Attach the bird strike protection (1) to the forward bulkhead with these parts:
 - The six bolts (4)
 - The six washers (3)
 - The six nuts (2).
- 7 Torque the six nuts (2) to the standard torque value. Refer to 39-A-20-00-00A-711A-A.

Requirements After Job Completion

- 1 Remove all the tools and the other items from the work area. Make sure that the work area is clean.
- 2 Close the access door 213AL. Refer to 39-A-06-41-00-00A-010A-A
